Dear John Moore.

Amherst, My Dear Sir.

I gave to Jacob Fanny  
a cooper in St Lucia, under date of  
August 13th a draft on you for \$746.80.  
My reason for so doing, was that  
C. C. Mikes had told me he would  
give me a draft on you for  
\$900 for beams, & in keeping  
for the beams I had to disburse  
nearly all the money I had, nearly  
\$3000, & was obliged to get this  
from Charley. I intended going up  
to day & settle it with you, but  
Charley is absent, & as soon as he  
returns I will get the draft from  
him, & send it to you.

I promised Mr. C. Fanny a young  
man who has been overseeing for  
me to try & get you to give

write a letter to Gen Taylor to permit  
them to go on & join Capt Set Blair's  
company in Virginia.

I had yesterday a letter from  
Franklin saying that there were  
two negroes belonging to one  
of us in jail at Soffouraker one

of. I have never seen any so it  
must be William & Charles.

William is below now.

I have such an amount of  
stocking that it almost prevents  
the usual labor giving on
