Dear Sir

Please deliver to Mr. A. B. Wofford or bearer, Ninety
Hundred pounds of salt, ~~and~~ charge the same to Mr. McNeill of
St. Louis for labour for (37) thirty seven days, by Slack & Tyle at 58[¢] per
day, & labour for thirty seven days, by Rice at 38[¢] per day; Freight in
salt at six dollars per sack, as per contract made by me with
Mr. McNeill for account of Mrs. Wofford. Please deliver to Mr.
Wofford or bearer, also - twenty six hundred pounds of salt, & charge
to my account. It being an amount due her for two carts.
