

Shreveport September 25<sup>th</sup> 1863

My dear Sir

In compliance with your request we have called upon Gen<sup>t</sup> Anderson and was informed that he had just rec<sup>d</sup> your documents - but, Gen<sup>t</sup> Smith had no authority and could not act or interfere in the premises.

The Market for Sugar and Molasses is quite limited. Sugar, ranging from 30 to 50<sup>c</sup> according to grade fine - Extra 55<sup>c</sup>. Molasses - 65<sup>c</sup> first quality.

In regard to Texas - Every place of value seems to be taken so far as my observation and inquiries led in the section that I visited. There was some places reported in Smith County for sale but none to rent that would meet your wishes -
